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## LEGAL NOTICE

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# PEHM

**If You Worked for Advanced Medical Transport (Peoria Hospitals Mobile Medical Services, d/b/a Advanced Medical Transport of Central Illinois or Advanced Medical Transport of Springfield, Inc.) and Utilized a Finger Scan Timekeeping System, You May be Entitled to Compensation.**

A Settlement has been reached in a class action lawsuit about whether Advanced Medical Transport (“Defendants”) captured and stored biometric information.

**The Court has not decided who is right.**

**Who’s Included?** The Settlement includes: **All individuals who work or worked for Defendants in the State of Illinois and who used a finger scan timekeeping system in connection with their employment with Defendants from May 11, 2018 to January 4, 2021.** You received this Notice because records show that you are a Settlement Class Member.

**What Are the Settlement Terms?** Defendants have agreed to pay Settlement Class Members and to pay for notice and administration costs of the Settlement, attorneys’ fees and expenses incurred by counsel for the Settlement Class, and a Service Award for Plaintiff. Defendants will pay \$482,090.00 (the “Settlement Fund”). Each Settlement Class Member shall be sent a Claim Settlement Check by the Administrator on a pro rata basis not to exceed \$920.00 per claimant (prior to the subtraction of a pro rata portion of any and all approved Notice and Administrative Costs, the Service Awards and any Attorneys’ Fees and Expenses, which is estimated to result in a total net amount of \$500.00-\$550.00 for each Settlement Class Member).

**How Can I Get a Payment?** To get a payment, you do not need to take any further action.

**Your Other Options.** If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement, you must exclude yourself by **October 2, 2024**. If you do not exclude yourself, you will release any claims you may have, as more fully described in the Settlement Agreement, available at the Settlement Website. You may object to the Settlement by **October 2, 2024**. The Long-Form Notice available on the Settlement Website explains how to exclude yourself or object. The Court will hold a Final Approval Hearing on **October 22, 2024** to consider whether to approve the Settlement, a request for attorneys’ fees of up to \$183,194.20 in actual costs, and a Service Award of \$5,000.00 to the Class Representative. You may appear at the hearing, either yourself or through an attorney you hire, but you don’t have to. For more information, call or visit the Settlement Website.
